

Reminders and Helpful Information:

1. You may park in our parking lot and in the church parking lot across the street. Use a parking space. Do not park in the grass in either lot.
2. Please supervise students and children heavily in both parking lots **and** throughout the night. Teachers will not be on duty. Our playground will be closed. Please help us keep all children safe by adhering to these rules.
3. Students will be admitted to the classrooms at **5:45**. They will use this time to get ready and set up. Please have your child dressed in costume before arrival, if they have one. They will need to go to the classroom by themselves. Fifth grade will report to the Assembly Building.
4. Parents are not allowed into the classrooms before **6:00**. If you get here early, you can line up at the side gate.
5. Once admitted, we encourage you to view **ALL** classrooms and ask the students about their project. They have lots of information ready to share with you! *Some good questions are: Can you tell me about your project? What is the most interesting thing you have learned?*
6. Continue to view and visit until **6:45**. Once the closing announcement has been made, return to your child's classroom to get your child.
7. Check with your child's teacher about whether or not they would like you to take the Museum projects home.

DEFY GRAVITY TEEN TRIP


